IS 2007 will provide an international forum for scientists, academicians and professionals to present their latest research findings in the various fields of Information Society.

The multiconference will consist of the following six carefully selected conferences:

- **Intelligent Systems**
- **Collaboration and Information Society**
- **Data Mining and Data Warehouses (SiKDD 2007)**
- **Education in Information Society**
- **Cognitive Sciences**
- **Slovenian Demographic Challenges in the 21st Century**

The information society is changing the world and affecting the Slovene society. The aim of the multiconference is not to provide final answers, but to open discussions and bold explorations and to enhance interdisciplinary scientific debate between the fields of the individual conferences. IS 2007 will serve as a forum for the world-wide and national community to explore current and future trends, further directions, business opportunities and governmental policies – both European and American. The main objective is the exchange of ideas and development of visions for the future of the information society.

Prospective authors are invited to submit full papers presenting new research related to the conference topics. Submitted papers must be original and not currently under review by another conference or journal. They should stimulate the development of the information society and incorporate recent developments. Submitted papers should not be too technical in nature. Calls for papers for individual conferences are being sent out by mail. Each conference has its own deadline for submission of papers ranging from August 12 to September 10, 2007. The papers can be in English or in Slovene, depending on the conference, and should be four pages long in most cases.
