


THE SLOVENIAN-ISRAELI DAY OF SCIENCE AND INNOVATION

Over the past decade Israel has emerged as a one of the world's leading technological giants. Remarkably, despite its small size, Israel ranks first in the world in venture capital investments as a percentage of GDP and first in R&D investment. It has the second-largest number of startup companies in the world (after the United States). Israel is home to 12 Nobel Prize laureates and a pioneer in industries ranging from biotechnology to financial engineering.
