Dr. David Adam is an award winning journalist and a best-selling author. Over a twenty year career he has written thousands of articles for newspapers and magazines around the world, including Nature, Science and New Scientist. As a specialist correspondent for the Guardian he reported from Antarctica, the Arctic and the depths of the Amazon jungle. As a commissioning editor at Nature he featured the work and ideas of scientists around the world. He is now a full time freelancer, specialising in writing and editing, and he is also training others to do so.
