Dr. Tina Lebar has won a European Research Council project (ERC Starting Grant 2024) to start an independent research career that will be based at the National Institute of Chemistry. The project focuses on the development of molecular tools that target safe genomic locations using high-throughput experimental methods. The aim of the project is to develop genome editing technologies that can overcome the limitations of current tools, and the research aims to increase the efficacy, safety and sustainability of therapies for the treatment of genetic diseases.

During the presentation, the project leader Dr. Lebar will address the audience via video link, and the Director of the National Institute of Chemistry, Prof. Dr. Gregor Anderluh, will explain the importance of ERC projects.

The presentation will be held in Slovenian.
